The Dee Campbell Junior Rowing Scholarship Application Form

Halifax Rowing Association (HRA), a 501C-3 organization located in Daytona Beach, FL was organized to foster the sport of rowing in the Daytona Beach Area. In addition to providing a local rowing facility for active rowers, the club is dedicated to increasing awareness of the sport in the community through programs, events, and education. To further our mission and through the generous donation of Dee Campbell, an accomplished rower, coach, and life-long supporter of the sport, HRA has created the Dee Campbell Junior Rowing Scholarship to assist young scholar athletes in pursuing and enjoying the sport of rowing.

A positive “all in” attitude and a strong sense of community were two very important character traits that Dee Campbell cherished. HRA will only consider scholar athletes who embrace his spirit of outstanding effort and volunteerism. His scholarship will assist athletes who are of high character and embrace the values of hard work and team effort.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a rising Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior; no younger than 12 and no older than 18-years-of-age.
- Applicant must be a permanent resident of Volusia County.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled in a public school, private school, or homeschooling program located in Volusia County.
- Applicant must show an unweighted grade point average of 3.0 or above. If chosen as the scholarship recipient, applicant will submit a grade report at the end of each semester.
- Applicant must attend at least 95% of practices held within a month. Excessive absences will result in forfeiture of the award.
- Applicant must provide a current physician-signed physical.
- Applicant must be able to provide or obtain reliable transportation to and from practices and HRA related events.
- Applicant must demonstrate a financial need.

Additional Requirements/Qualifications:

- Applicant must be able to demonstrate adequate swimming skills.
- Applicant must be able to comfortably lift overhead a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Applicant must abide by his/her schools and the HRA Code of Conduct at all times.
- Applicant must provide one letter of reference. This letter must come from a person outside of the immediate family (teacher, employer, neighbor, etc.).
- Applicant must provide a written response to two questions (500 words or less, TOTAL).
